1. In a recent publication describing paid time off benefits for employees, the University inadvertently omitted the Union Week recess (December 25 through January 1) on the Harvard Holiday Calendar for 2008 and 2009. The University has apologized for any confusion, and will be publishing a clarification in the next issue of the Resource. There has been no change from the current agreement to the new tentative agreement in the Union Week recess that we have been enjoying since it was first negotiated in 1999.

2. The ratification vote for our new tentative agreement will take place on June 19. A Notice of Election with details of voting times and locations has been mailed to the work addresses of all HUCTW members.
