2. Academic Enrichment Fellowship

In 2007, the Academic Enrichment Fellowship was expanded to cover more types of expenses as well as a larger age range (now children 5-18).

The Fellowship assists with the cost of academic enrichment such as college application fees; academic tutoring; exam fees and SAT/ACT test prep classes; academic-based camp, academic afterschool program, or academic extracurricular activity. The award cycle runs from September 1, 2007 to August 30, 2008. The application deadline is August 1, 2008 and awards will be allocated at the end of August 2008.
