Readers will include past Poet Laureate of the US, Robert Pinsky, Harvard's Jorie Graham, Rosanna Warren, Gail Mazur, Haitian poet Patrick Sylvain and others; one of the poets will be HUCTW's own Frannie Lindsay.

Authors' books will be on sale for signing from the Harvard Bookstore, which is donating all proceeds after cost to PIH.

Poets for Haiti is a small contribution to an enormous humanitarian effort underway. The National Nurses Union has reportedly 11,000 nurses who have volunteered to go to Haiti, and other unions are contributing to relief efforts. We hope that this event, in addition to being a fine night of poetry, will stimulate support for PIH and help deepen our connection to the people of Haiti.
